





### **10 EFSA SCIENTIFIC PANELS:**


- Composed of idependent scientific experts
- With a 3-year mandate
- Carry out scientific assessments and develop related assessment methodologies
- The latest mandate began on 1 July 2018.

#### **SCIENTIFIC COMMITTEE:**

- The Chairs, Vice-Chairs, Members of Scientific Panels
- Provides general co-ordination to ensure consistency in the scientific opinions prepared by EFSA's SP.
- Provides strategic scientific advice to EFSA's management.






- Comprises representatives of the National Food Safety Authorities from the 28 EU MSs, Iceland and Norway
- Observers from Switzerland, the EU Candidate Countries and the Commission also attend Advisory Forum meetings
- AF: Joint forces of EFSA and EU MSs for addressing EU risk assessment and risk communication issues
- Advises EFSA on scientific matters, its work programmes and priorities, identifies emerging risks as early as possible.



#### **PEOPLE – THE FOCAL POINT NETWORK**

- Comprises members from all 28 EU MSs, Iceland and Norway, as well as observers from Switzerland and the EU Candidate Countries
- Act as ambassadors in EU MSs and operate as a network of cross-border collaboration on food safety
- Assist in the Exchange of scientific information, <u>Advise</u> on cooperation activities and scientific projects
- <u>Promote</u> trainings in risk assessment, <u>Raise</u> EFSA's scientific visibility and outreach in MS.








#### SCIENTIFIC COOPERATION: HOW? THE EU-RAA Project





 EFSA has been developing its EU Risk Assessment Agenda to identify shared interests between Member States and EFSA with a view to align and to collaborate on the most important topics


